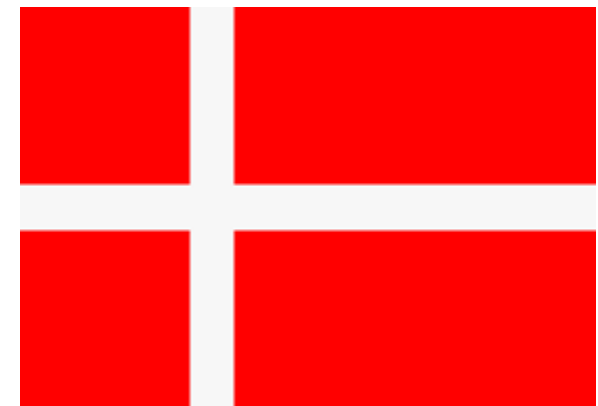

Program Overview

Shoreline Community College offers an exciting opportunity for students in the Visual Communication Technology and Business Administration/Marketing programs to study at Business Academy Southwest in Esbjerg, Denmark. This exchange opportunity occurs each Fall Quarter/Semester.

Esbjerg is located on the west coast of Denmark and, as a port town, is the 5th largest city in Denmark. Esbjerg boasts the longest pedestrian mall in all of Denmark, where family and friends meet to shop and socialize. Nearby beaches are a favorite recreation spot as well. Esbjerg is home to several colleges including Business Academy Southwest, a technical/professional college, where Shoreline students can study business administration, marketing or visual communication technology and earn credits toward their Shoreline degree.

While living in Esbjerg, students will learn new perspectives in their field, meet students from around the world, and will become familiar with the history, culture, and people of Denmark.

Student participants directly enroll in the academic program, taking all cohort courses. Accommodations are available in a dormitory (single rooms) located next to the Academy.



About Denmark

Denmark is located in northern Europe and is the connecting country between Central Europe and Scandinavia. Denmark boasts the longest unbroken line of monarchs, having had 50 kings and 2 Queens. Denmark has a temperate coastal climate that is similar to Seattle with the hottest month in July, and the coolest in January. The land is characterized by impressive tidal flats, beaches, parks and an abundance of birds and animals.

Program Requirements

To participate in the Danish exchange program, SCC students must:

- Have a minimum GPA of 2.75
- Have completed 30 credits at Shoreline Community College
- Be a student in Visual Communication Technology or Business Administration programs
- Have their application approved by SCC faculty in their department

Prices and Fees

- Roundtrip Airfare Seattle-Copenhagen (~\$1000)
- Roundtrip Train Ticket Copenhagen-Esbjerg (~ \$100)
- Passport and Student Visa (~ \$200)
- Accommodation (~\$350/mo. single room)
- Meals (~\$300/mo.)
- Local Transportation (~\$100/mo. OR buy a used bicycle for ~\$100!)
- Personal Expenses
- SCC tuition for 15-20 credits
