



The Study Abroad Scholarship Committee will award a maximum of 5 - \$500 Summer Institute scholarships and 1 -\$1000 BAW Denmark Exchange Program scholarship in 2009. Awards are for use on SCC Summer Institutes and BAW Denmark Programs only and must be used in the year they are awarded. Scholarships are non-renewable. The scholarship dollars will be applied to the final payment of the program fee. Award payments will be made to the college on behalf of the recipient. Scholarship recipients will be asked to work with the Assistant Director of International Education to share their study abroad experience with other students (for example helping with a study abroad info meeting, sharing photos or writings for use on the school website.)

Applications are DUE by 5pm on April 6, 2009

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must have been enrolled at Shoreline at least 2 quarters between Fall 2007 and Spring 2009.
- Must be applying to or accepted into a 2009 SCC Summer Institute or BAW Denmark Study Abroad Program
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident
- Must have Financial Need (as determined by FAFSA) **AND/OR** be from a population that is underrepresented in Study Abroad programs. This includes students who are any of the following:
1) male 2) non-Caucasian, or 3) 24 years or older.

Preference is given to:

Students who demonstrate excellence in a combination of their resume, essay, and transcript.

Application Requirements:

- Completed Application Form with Signature
- Current Unofficial SCC Transcript
- Essay
- Resume

Determination of Award:

The application will be reviewed by the Study Abroad Scholarship Committee. Recipients will be notified of their award before the first payment deadline for the program of their choice.

Award Recognition

Scholarship Recipients will be recognized May 20, 2009 at the SCC Foundation Spring Scholarship Celebration.
